Most of us share the feeling that the teaching of an interdisciplinary field spanning logic, linguistics and computer science should be available in such a way that will facilitate further interdisciplinary research. Nevertheless, we are aware that the needs are different in those fields of study which have already been established. The overall concern is in the teaching of logic, but with special regard in addressing innovations and the systematization of educational activity.

We believe that the role of logic in the shaping of the epistemology of this XXI century should be crucial; Information technology is rapidly changing the world we live in, and logic is helping us to produce, distribute and process information, as well as to understand how coded information can modify people's state of knowledge.

At the University of Salamanca the First International Congress on Tools for Teaching Logic will take place in June 2000. A number of logicians from different countries in Europe, the US and Latin America will gather there to focus on education on the interfaces between philosophy, linguistics, mathematics, computer science and related disciplines.

This Congress has been organized by the ARACNE group, a network of ALFA created in 1998 to produce Tools for Teaching Logic. We all appreciate the good response obtained from the International Community and enjoy the positive and practical character of most contributions.
